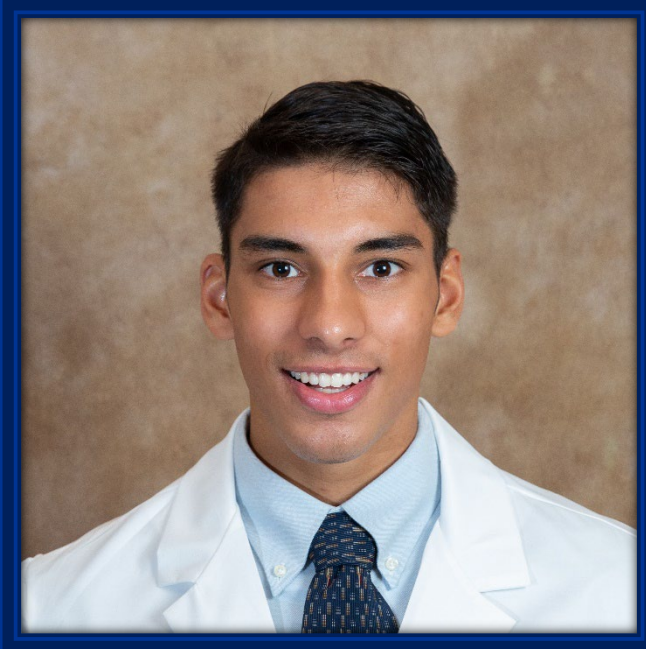


Pitt Med Professionalism Accolade
